







# C4Y WATER CHAMPIONS YOUTH FELLOWSHIP

The six month prestigious Water Champions Youth Fellowship programme is designed to disseminate knowledge on India's water sector, building awareness on management of the water resources and enable a cadre of water managers and sustainability professionals in India. The programme envisions to contribute in enhancing capacities, knowledge and innovation among the youth so that they can explore disruptive concepts for reducing India's unrelenting water challenges with mentoring from sectoral experts.

Women candidates are especially encouraged to apply. Students having a keen desire to share ideas with others, to be challenged, to be inspired, with a willingness to face obstacles and come up with solutions for a way ahead may apply. 

- Issue a forwarding certificate to the applicant student which is a mandatory requirement post selection.
- Include the fellowship as mandated summer internship and subsume the successful completion of the fellowship as integral part of the curriculum requirement for this academic year.
- Depute a faculty as an academic mentor & point of contact to facilitate the learning process of the students as fellow.
- Extend all necessary support to the selected student for an enriching experience.
- Seek and provide regular review updates on the progress of the fellows selected from the institution.
